

Picasso Sculpture Year 8 Home learning Project 16th January – 17th February

Weeks 1 – 5

Your mission is to create a Picasso style sculpture using a selection of materials and present to your class during your art lesson the week commencing 20th February. You should be able to discuss your sculpture, your ideas behind it and how you made it.

Week 1 - Research as many different Picasso sculptures as you can. Once you have found enough inspiration collect materials to create your sculpture ie newspaper, string, cardboard , glue, plastic cups

Week 2 - Begin to create your sculpture- plan your time carefully to allow for glue or paint to dry if you are using them.

Week 3 - Develop and refine your sculpture - ask parents, friends and siblings what they think you could do to improve your design.

Week 4 – Continue to refine your sculpture from the advice your parents and siblings gave you, you could take photos to help with your presentation , t

Week 5 - Add the finishing touches to your design - write a short presentation that you will read out when you present your sculpture to the class.

Success Criteria Picasso Sculpture

- **Your sculpture should be 3 Dimensional and at least the height of an A4 piece of paper, ie 30 cm**
- **It should be clear from your sculpture that you have looked at Picassos work and based your sculpture on one of his designs.**
- **Your design should be innovative and creative.**
- **You should be able to say how you developed and refined your idea.**
- **Your sculpture must be finished to the best of your ability.**
- **You should be able to present your work to the class and explain your idea and how you made it.**

The best work will be displayed in the art exhibition at the end of the summer term.
