Dear Parents and Carers,

Re: Year 11 Sports Studies Intervention

As we enter the second year of Sport Studies, students are beginning the examination unit of the course. This means that there may be extra stress and less time to complete or improve any overdue coursework in lessons.

Your son/daughter is currently not meeting their potential in either their coursework or their examination preparation and so I am asking them to attend Sport Studies intervention to help support them. **These sessions are on every Monday in G2 with Mrs Humphrey from 3:15pm-4.30pm and they are required to attend these sessions until they meet the expected Pass mark or more for each unit.**

I would like to remind parents and students that learners have to achieve at least a **Pass** in each of the four units of coursework in order to pass the course, which is why handing in all coursework and passing the final exam is of the utmost importance. By achieving a basic Pass grade students will achieve the equivalent of a GCSE 4-5 grade while a Merit is the equivalent of a GCSE 6 grade, a Distinction the equivalent of a GCSE 7-8 grade and a Distinction* the equivalent of a GCSE 9 grade.

I am hopeful that with some extra time and support that your son/daughter will achieve their target grade or above. Once coursework is up to date, the invitation to continue intervention sessions to help with examination preparation is also available.
