Re: KS3 – Design and Technology Materials

During the course of the first three academic years your child will be involved in the design and realisation of various projects as part of their Key Stage 3 National Curriculum Design and Technology course. Your child will work through a programme of projects which will offer practical experience in plastics, electronics, metalwork, woodwork and catering.

All basic materials are provided in all of these areas, except in the case of the hospitality & catering area where there are specifics required by individual students, and then we ask that students bring in their own ingredients, which they should then take home in a suitable container.

However, further materials, components and ingredients required for successful completion of these projects exceed our limited budget and I therefore write to request a parental contribution towards their costs. The cost per student for the three years will be £12. Upon completion of each of the projects, the made items become your child's property and we would strongly encourage them to take each one home.
