A coach is booked for 14:15 to take us to Luton airport for our flight.


Day one. Friday 31st March

Our coach transfer will take us to the Hotel H Top Olympic, arriving at approx. 23:30pm.


Room keys will be allocated, and the hotel will provide food for us if pupils want something before bed.

As we arrive late, it is advised that pupils have a small amount of spending money to buy snacks at the airport.




Day two. Saturday 1st April

Spending money

You many wish to provide a small amount of spending money for souvenirs, snacks etc.

We recommend a pre-paid card for travelling, such as those provided by Monzo or Revolut.

This allows you to see transactions and manage the card through an app in case of emergencies and is often safer than carrying cash.

Kit list



Clothing:

Comfortable clothing appropriate for Spanish Spring weather. The average temperature will be 20°C.

Jeans and T-shirt with a light jumper for evenings, and comfortable trainers for walking.

When visiting the Cathedrals, it is important to dress conservatively. Avoid crop tops, vest tops, shorts or miniskirts. Bring a light jumper on these days to cover up if needed.

We highly recommend a bum bag or similar to carry essentials. These are safer in a tourist / city environment and minimise the risk of pickpocketing.
