## Re. Current Year 8 and 9 Geography/Science Trip To Iceland – Tuesday 2<sup>nd</sup> April to Saturday 6<sup>th</sup> April 2024

We are delighted to inform you that we are in a position to offer our current Year 8 and Year 9 students the opportunity to attend the above overseas visit, providing a programme of exciting activities and excursions to complement Geography & Science studies

There are 40 spaces available for this visit.

The cost will be £980, which includes transport, full board accommodation, resort coaching, programme of activities and excursions as detailed below:

- Ljosafoss Hep power station
- Perlan Observation Deck
- Laugardalslaug swimming pool
- Efstidalur ice cream farm
- Golden Circle Day including Thingvellir National Park to experience tectonic plate boundaries, Geysir Geo-thermal area and Gullfoss waterfall
- South Coast Day including: Seljalandsfoss and Skogafoss waterfalls, Reynisfjara black sand beach and basalt columns, Dryholaey coastal features and the town of Vik
- Reykjanes Peninsula including: Bridge between continents, Gunnuhver hot springs, Krysuvik mud puddles, Reykjanes lighthouse, Stora Eldborg
- Downtown Reykjavik explore and souvenir shopping
- Hveragerdi town with FST guided tour plus potential to visit shake house

We will travel by air and executive coach, fitted with seat belts, and have arranged 4 nights' accommodation at Guest House, Husid.

If you would like your child to be considered for a place on this visit please register your interest by completing the expression of interest form below by Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June 2022. Please note that this does not quarantee them a place. Confirmation of place/s will be advised as soon as possible after this date.

Payment of the non refundable deposit of £125 will be required by Monday 13<sup>th</sup> June 2022. The payment plan will then run from September 2022 to July 2023.
